### Materials list:

Sewing Machine with the ability to drop the feed dogs, free motion foot, bobbins, needles.

Thread: light/medium/dark greens and browns, variegated works best, black and monofilament (invisible).

Embroidery Hoop that fits under the needle of your machine, about 9" dia.

Scissors: A medium or large pair and a sharp tiny pair, curved embroidery scissors work well.

Pins, Glue stick, Fray check, Colored pencils, cheap ones work fine, make sure they are not water color pencils.

Iron and small ironing surface.

Fabric: white cotton at least 18"x18", this will be the foundation. 2 or more cotton fabric scraps that fit your hoop, the color doesn't matter as we will be cutting this fabric away after creating thread branches.

Batting scraps

Optional Materials: I will bring these items to share in class but if you already have any of them please bring them.

Permanent markers, like sharpies or fabric pens, any felt tip type pen marked permanent.

Basting glue, needle tip is the easiest to use.

Heavy starch

Chalk markers, I use chaco liners.

### Kit includes:

All background and motif Fabrics needed for quilt top without borders, several colors of netting and sheers, water soluble stabilizer, and tear-away stabilizer, wonder under, fabric medium, foam brush.
